Critical Principles of Civil Online Interactions (1)


Clarity and Precision

Active Listening

Listen to others' viewpoints. Acknowledge their perspectives to show you value their input.




Empathy and Respect

Constructive Feedback

Offer feedback that is helpful and encouraging. Focus on solutions rather than problems.
